The deadline to submit proposals is **January 21, 2025**. All proposals should include the following:

- Engaging program format that involves the audience and stimulates discussion.
- Qualified presenters with expertise/experience in the subject matter and presentations may include one or more presenters.
- Presentations will be reviewed for relevance and purpose to provide a balanced educational program. Presenters may apply for each presentation type.
- Presenters will be notified about their proposal status via email by January 28th, 2025.
- Presenters receive a complimentary conference registration but neither honorarium nor expenses.

Roundtable Mini Session will occur with multiple sessions going on in the room simultaneously, plan for a 14-minute discussion that would be repeated three times with an audience typically of 10-20 people each round.
